



Woven Journey Children's Program Facilitator

(Part-time, Temporary – 1 year contract)

iHuman Youth Society is a non-profit, charitable organization whose mission is to serve young adults and promote their reintegration into the community through a program involving crisis intervention, arts mentorship, and life skills development. Situated on Treaty 6 Territory in the Boyle Street neighborhood, iHuman provides developmental opportunities that focus on the principles of creativity, authenticity and caring for members between the ages of 12 and 24.

Reporting to the Authenticity Director, the Woven Journey Children's Program Facilitator, provides childcare supervision and purposeful programming for children (infants to 10 years) while their parents participate in Woven Journey programming. The Children's Program Facilitator will work with others collaboratively in developing and implementing programming standards and systems in accordance with iHuman's policies, practices and risk management protocols. This is a temporary, part-time, one (1) year contract position that is expected to end March 2021.

Responsibilities:

- Develop and deliver engaging, educational and fun programming for children
- Build trusting and meaningful relationships with parents/guardians and their children
- Support engagement with parents/guardians and provide input on activities and meal preparation and cleaning as it relates to children
- Provide a safe environment for children and participate in planning activities, outings and events in accordance with needs of children
- Participate in program evaluation and contribute to overall improvements to ensure effectiveness

Qualifications:

- Post-secondary education in a related field. Combination of education/experience may be considered
- Knowledge and awareness of TRC, intergenerational trauma and Indigenous culture/protocols
- Experience working with vulnerable and marginalized young people (ages 12-24 years)
- Must have a passion for working with children (infants to 10 years) and a knowledge of healthy brain development
- Well-developed leadership and mentorship skills
- Excellent ability to manage high stress situations, multi-task and demonstrate initiative
- Clear Criminal Record Check, Child Intervention Check
- Standard First Aid/CPR, Infant CPR and food safety compliance
- Computer competency with Mac and PC
