iHuman Youth Society is a non-profit, charitable organization whose mission is to serve young adults and promote their reintegration into the community through a program involving crisis intervention, arts mentorship, and life skills development. Situated on Treaty 6 Territory in the Boyle Street neighborhood, iHuman provides developmental opportunities that focus on the principles of creativity, authenticity and caring for members between the ages of 12 and 24.

Reporting to the Director, Authenticity Programs, the Program Facilitator, Woven Journey is committed to a youth-driven engagement approach and working collaboratively to deliver crisis intervention and outreach services to marginalized and traumatized young people.

Responsibilities:

- Implement harm reduction strategies to encourage and support a healthy lifestyle
- Establish trust relationships with young people, develop case planning, de-escalation and goal setting action plans
- Facilitate and provide advocacy for young people and their families collaborating with external agencies, government services and community resources
- Develop and implement protocols to engage Indigenous youth, which involves working closely
 with youth, coaching to overcome barriers, introducing cultural and traditional knowledge into
 the young people's experiences, and supporting and empowering youth
- Conduct on-going evaluations to ensure program outcomes are achieved
- Maintain records and prepare reports

Qualifications:

- Post-secondary education in a related field. Combination of education/experience may be considered.
- Experience working with marginalized populations including vulnerable youth
- Well-developed network of contacts and strong cultural connections to the Indigenous community
- Experience facilitating youth with court appearances
- Knowledge of applying harm reduction approaches to engaging youth with multiple challenges including mental illness, addictions and fetal alcohol syndrome
- Excellent conflict resolution, debriefing, interviewing and case planning skills
- Clear Criminal Record Check, Child and Youth Services Check
- Valid Driver's License and access to a reliable vehicle
- Artistic skills are an asset
- Adaptability, flexibility and teamwork skills required
- Computer competency with Mac and PC
